Bishop, California is a friendly town nestled in between two majestic mountain ranges, the iconic Sierra Nevada mountains to the West, and the White Mountains to the East. Bishop is home to the <u>Bishop Paiute Tribe</u>. The Paiute people who live on the Bishop Paiute Reservation are descendants of the "Nu-Mu", the original people of the Owens Valley. Today the Paiute people are the fifth largest California Tribe, with 2,000 members and one of the smallest land bases. Petroglyphs that were left by the ancestors of the Paiute Tribe are all around. Bishop lies in a valley that is around 4,000 feet in elevation and receives an average of 5 inches of rain a year. Classified as a high desert, plants and animals must adapt to the arid environment. Wildlife viewing in Bishop is rich and abundant and you can find Tule Elk and Mule Deer in the winter months, and in the Spring and Autumn skies witness a great migration. Birdwatching in any season is popular, and the hunting season in Fall and Winter draws many enthusiasts.
