Dear Sirs:

On January 14, 2003, representatives of Plume County CUPA conducted an inspection at 123 Plume Drive, Plume, California (the "Facility"). Based on information from the inspection, Plume County CUPA is preparing to bring an administrative action against the owner of Any Oil Corporation to ensure compliance and assess penalties, pursuant to Section 25404.1.1 of the California Health and Safety Code. A copy of the inspection report is enclosed.

The administrative action being considered includes violations of the California Code of Regulations, 23 C.C.R. Ch. 16, §2637(a). This regulation requires underground storage tank owners and operators to conduct secondary containment testing by January 1, 2003. Plume County has repeatedly notified Any Oil Corporation of this requirement and Any Oil Corporation has willingly chosen not to comply.

Before filing an Administrative Enforcement Order and Notice of Defense (hereinafter "Order") against the owner of Any Oil Corporation, Plume County CUPA is extending the opportunity to advise Plume County CUPA of any other information that should be considered before filing an Order against the owner of Any Oil Corporation. You may also take this opportunity to commence settlement discussions concerning the alleged violations at your

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business. If you wish to submit such information, please direct it to:

Any penalty proposed for violations of Title 23 CCR Chapter 16, §2637(a) will be calculated pursuant to Health and Safety Code Chapter 6.7, §25299(a).
