**Background:** The Imperial County Fire Department has filed an application with the Secretary for Environmental Protection at the California Environmental Protection Agency (CalEPA). It seeks to become the Certified Unified Program Agency (CUPA) for Imperial County. The Unified Program consolidates, coordinates, and makes consistent the administrative requirements, permits, inspections, and enforcement activities of six California environmental and emergency response programs relating to the management of hazardous materials. The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) currently serves as the CUPA for Imperial County.

The public hearing will provide an opportunity for members of the public to provide comments for the Secretary's consideration.
