This Agenda is to provide notice that the Site Designation Committee will be considering applications at a public meeting (on the above date) submitted pursuant to Health and Safety Code sections 25260 through 25268.

Notice: Testimony will be taken from those who identify themselves as wishing to speak at the beginning of the proceedings. Speakers for each item will be called in the following order: Applicant, Proposed Administering Agency, Representatives of Organizations, Governmental agencies, and other interested parties. Please note that there may be time limits placed upon testimony according to the number of parties who wish to participate.

## Action may be taken on any item listed on the agenda.

- 1. Call to order, roll call, and establishment of quorum (Lynne Baker, Acting Chair)
- 2. Receive testimony, discuss, and take possible action on the responsible party's request for designation of Administering Agency and to create an Advisory Team (if requested at the hearing) for 4212-4220 Piedmont Avenue, Oakland, Alameda County, California that includes Assessor Parcel Number 012-990-020. This site is located in a commercial district and consists of approximately 0.15 acres. The two-story building located along Piedmont Avenue is comprised of four street-level commercial retail tenant spaces and four residential apartments located above the retail spaces. Dry cleaners formerly operated at 4214 and 4220 Piedmont Avenue.

The Committee will hear testimony only from those who identify themselves as wanting to speak at the beginning of the proceeding. Testimony may be restricted to the following time limits according to the number of parties who wish to testify. Testimony will be heard from parties in the following order:

- 1. The applicant (maximum of 20 minutes)
- 2. Proposed Administering Agency (maximum of 20 minutes)
- 3. Representatives of organizations (maximum of 20 minutes each)
- 4. Governmental agencies

(maximum of 10 minutes each)

5. Individual (maximum of 5 minutes each)

The Committee may modify these time limits if conditions warrant. Written comments may be submitted prior to or during the meeting. If submitting comments prior to the meeting, please submit to Kristi Placencia by email at <u>Kristi.Placencia@calepa.ca.gov</u>. If submitting comments during the meeting, please provide 6 two-sided copies.

Members of the public may but are not obligated to provide their names or personal information as a condition of observing or participating in the meeting. #### CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY SITE DESIGNATION COMMITTEE RESOLUTION NO. [23-01] 4212-4220 Piedmont Avenue, Oakland, CA

#### July 19, 2023

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 6.65 of Division 20 of the Health and Safety Code, commencing with Section 25260, establishes a Site Designation Committee; and

**WHEREAS**, the Site Designation Committee may designate an Administering Agency to oversee a site investigation and remedial action at a hazardous materials release site upon request of a responsible party; and

WHEREAS, the applicant A Star Holdings, LLC, (owner of the Site and the responsible party) as defined in Health and Safety Code Section 25260(h), requested that the Site Designation Committee designate an Administering Agency to oversee site investigation and remedial action at 4212-4220 Piedmont Avenue, Alameda County, Oakland, California (the Site):

**WHEREAS**, this Site is a hazardous materials release site as defined in Health and Safety Code Section 25260(e); and

**WHEREAS**, the Site Designation Committee received the request for designation of Administering Agency on June 5, 2023; and

**WHEREAS**, the Site Designation Committee properly noticed a public meeting to consider the request; and

**WHEREAS**, the Site Designation Committee held a meeting on July 19, 2023, and provided an opportunity at the meeting for public comment regarding the application; and

**WHEREAS**, the Site Designation Committee considered the application and, furthermore, considered all factors and criteria set forth in Health and Safety Code Section 25262(c); and

WHEREAS, the Site Designation Committee has determined that, based upon consideration of all of the factors listed in Health and Safety Code Section 25262(c), the [Administering Agency] is the appropriate agency to act as the Administering Agency; and **WHEREAS**, A Star Holdings, LLC, agrees to reimburse the [Administering Agency], and any other appropriate agencies for their appropriate consultative and/or oversight costs and/or costs of permit development, where those agencies' significant involvement and/or permit development is necessary for the furtherance of the project goals.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Site Designation Committee hereby designates the [Administering Agency], as the Administering Agency for the Site; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this designation is subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The [Administering Agency] shall consult, on an ongoing basis, with the appropriate agencies that have expressed an interest in this Site, and all agencies that would otherwise be issuing a permit or other form of authorization:
  - a) In administering all state and local laws, which are applicable.
  - b) In determining the adequacy of site investigation and remedial action activities and in determining and imposing appropriate land use restrictions under Health and Safety Code section 25355.5.
  - c) Prior to issuing any permit or other form of authorization.

Such consultation will also include notification, if information becomes available to the [Administering Agency], that the original application was inaccurate or was incomplete.

- 2. The [Administering Agency] shall comply with applicable public participation requirements.
- 3. The [Administering Agency] shall submit to the Site Designation Committee an initial status report following consultation with appropriate state and local agencies, an annual status report (each October beginning October 1, 2023), and a final status report after project completion. A copy of these reports should also be sent to all appropriate agencies.

- 4. The [Administering Agency] shall provide at least 60 days notice to interested agencies and parties prior to issuing a certificate of completion for the Site.
- 5. If the Responsible Party who has agreed to perform all necessary cleanup as directed by the Administering Agency designated under this Resolution is the owner of the Site, and ownership of the property changes prior to issuance of the certificate of completion, then this designation of an Administering Agency is constructively terminated on the effective date of the ownership change, as to that owner/Responsible Party. However, if there are multiple Responsible Parties identified under this Resolution, those remaining Responsible Parties designated hereunder, by continuing to perform all necessary cleanup obligations as directed by the Administering Agency, will continue to garner the benefits of this Resolution.
